**Corporate Objective**

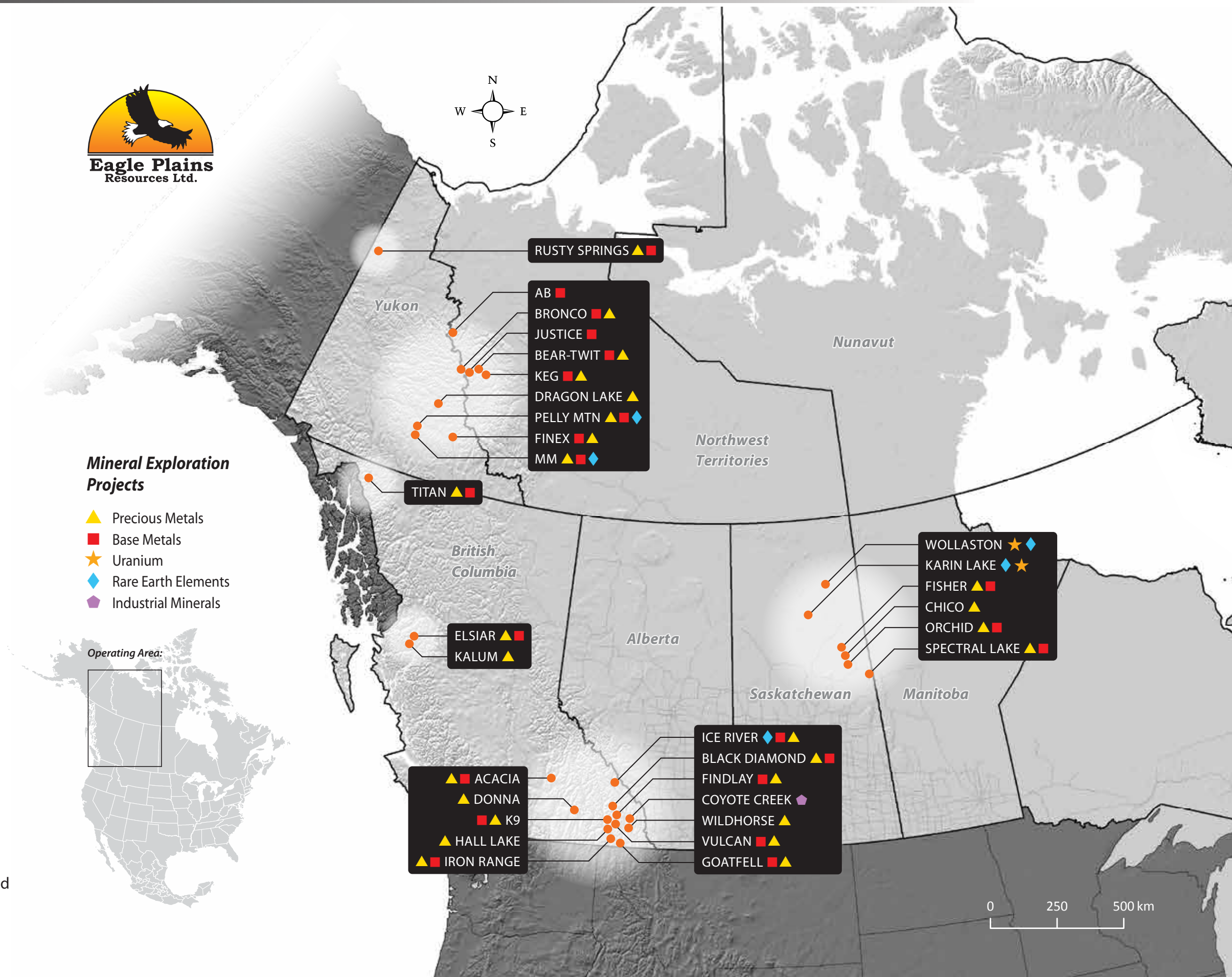
- Enhance shareholder value by exploring and developing early-stage opportunities in gold, silver, base-metals, uranium, REE's and industrial minerals.

**Eagle Plains Overview**

- No financing since 2009
- Holds dozens of net smelter royalties

- Owns hard assets including its own office building and acreage property
- Completed agreements with many large, mid-tier and junior companies

**2017 Highlights**

- Silver Standard Resources plans for a significant exploration program including diamond drilling at the Fisher Project, located adjacent their Seabee Mine Property
- Aben Resources plans for an extensive exploration program at the Chico Project located 5km south of the Fisher Project
- Eagle Plains is planning for an exploration program at their flagship project Iron Range (Au, Ag, Pb, Zn) as well as at Vulcan (Ag, Pb, Zn) and Orchid (Au, Ag)
- Additional exploration work is being planned for numerous other projects with budgets to be determined

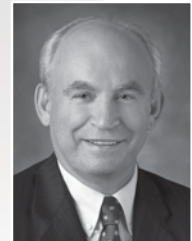
### **Glen J. Diduck**, CA - Director, Chief Financial Officer
